FEEDING DIRECTIONS

WHEY – Palatable. Develops bloom and show ring condition

BB Sheep Pro 35 is designed to be mixed with commodities and grains and fed to growing sheep. Consult your nutritionist for specific recommendations, or mix at the rate of 300#/ton Allow 5 to 7 days to make a feed change. Provide adequate bunk space. Adjust feeders to prevent feed wastage. Vaccinate lambs for enterotoxemia. Observe for signs of sickness or bloat. Make sure lambs always have access to fresh clean water at all times.

HIGH CALCIUM LEVEL – Important to balance the low calcium level of corn. Helps reduce the potential for urinary calculi.

CAUTION: This feed contains a source of non protein nitrogen. The equivalent protein supplied by non protein nitrogen, should not exceed 1/3 of the crude protein of the total ration. Use only as directed. No Copper compounds are added to this feed. However,
